## Report Crime

### Call Emergency: 9-1-1

When there is crime in progress, an immediate threat to life or property, a serious accident, or someone in crisis.

### Call Non-Emergency: 604-599-0502

To report a crime in Surrey where there are no suspects present, and no threat of violence or loss of life.
